As a privately owned business engaged in the manufacture, import, and distribution of medium-technology fluid-handling equipment, consumables, spare parts, meter verification and re-verification and associated services, Mechtronic recognises its responsibility to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking have no place within our operations or supply chains. Mechtronic is committed, as far as is reasonably practicable, to operating under a policy framework that prevents modern slavery in all its forms. We undertake rigorous due diligence when appointing new suppliers and conduct regular reviews of existing suppliers to ensure they uphold the same ethical standards. Our recruitment practices are transparent, consistent, and compliant with all relevant employment legislation.

Employees involved in procurement, supply chain management, and recruitment receive dedicated training on the Modern Slavery Act, equipping them to identify concerns and ensure compliance with this policy. Our management team fosters an open and approachable culture, actively promoting the company's commitment to safeguarding human rights and ethical working practices.

This statement and the supporting policy are reviewed annually. The review includes monitoring payroll data, assessing the completion of employee training on modern slavery, and evaluating supplier audit outcomes.
